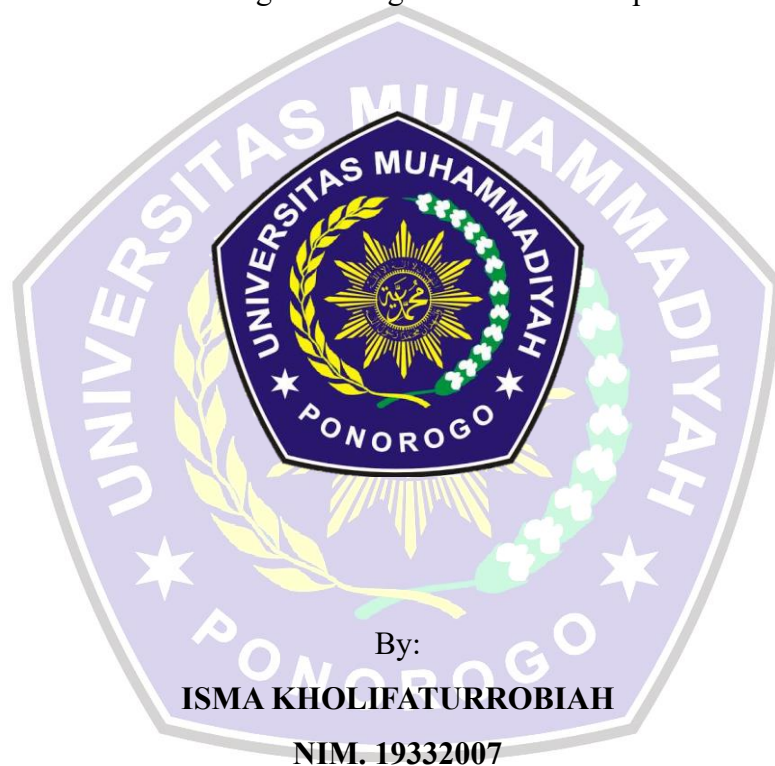

## ABSTRACT

**Keywords:** EFL Students Perception, English as Medium of Instruction, English Competence.

English strengthens its importance with requests for worker qualifications that require sufficient English language competence. The English competence was consisted of an outline of the fundamental abilities, information, attitudes, and behaviors needed to complete a task or activity in the real world. In English there are four competencies, namely writing, reading, listening and speaking. Schools as human resource printers have tried to achieve this competence by presenting English as medium of instruction (EMI) or use of the English language to instruct academic subjects.

This research was conducted at SMAN 3 Ponorogo which has implemented EMI in the form of SICP class. Respondents involved were 32 students in class 10<sup>th</sup> grade SICP. The method used is descriptive quantitative through a questionnaire in the form of a list of questions and documentation which analyzed using descriptive statistics. This study aims for uncovering students' perceptions with the presence of EMI towards students' English competence and their level of English competence after attending the SICP class as measured by the CEFR self-assessment grid.

The results showed that students' perceptions of English in the presence of EMI were considered positive with more than 20 students answering yes or the equivalent of more than 60% of the sample. It means students English competence improved. The indicator for the level of English competence is measured by the CEFR self-assessment range for with the majority answer around 40,6% or 41%. In conclusion, the students' perception of EMI in English competence was positive or can improve English competence and the English level had achieved the predetermined English competency.

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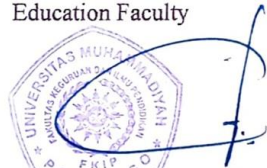
