ABSTRACT

Key Words: Interactive Writing, Scaffolding, and Writing

Writing is a communicative act; it is a way of sharing information, thoughts, experience, or ideas, between ourselves and others. In teaching writing, we can use strategy to improve students' writing skill. The strategy is Interactive Writing through Active Scaffolding. Interactive writing through active scaffolding is a form of shared writing or language experience lesson in which the teacher and students compose a story or text and share the pen in writing the words down on a chart or writing paper. The statement of problem of this research was how Interactive Writing through Active Scaffolding can improve students' writing skill at the eighth grade of MTs Muhammadiyah 2 Jenangan in academic year 2015/2016. The purpose of this research was to measure whether Interactive Writing through Active Scaffolding can improve students' writing skill at the eighth grade of MTs Muhammadiyah 2 Jenangan in academic year 2015/2016.

The subject of this research was the students of the eighth grade students of MTs Muhammadiyah 2 Jenangan in academic year 2015/2016 especially class VIIIB which consisted of 24 students. The research was started on 14^{th} September until 28^{th} September 2015 at around 12.20 p.m - 13.30 p.m. This research was conducted in two cycles. The researcher used three research instruments. There are observation check list, questionnaire, and test.

Based on the result of this research, the implementation of Interactive Writing through Active Scaffolding can improve students' writing skill at the eighth grade of MTs Muhammadiyah 2 Jenangan in academic year 2015/2016. It was seen from the improvement of the average score of the students from 72.84 % in cycle I up to 83.58 % in cycle II. The questionnaire and observation checklist also got improvement. The questionnaire in cycle I was 66.96 % up to 82.46 % in cycle II, while the observation was 67.85% in cycle I increased to 78.57 % in cycle II. It showed that students enjoyed and became active during teaching and learning process by using Interactive Writing through Active Scaffolding.

Finally, the researcher gives suggestions to the English teachers that they can use Interactive Writing through Active Scaffolding as alternative strategy in teaching writing. The next researcher can develop this strategy.

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
