

Speaking is a linguistic activity to share information because speaking is the productive oral skill in daily life. English day program is a program of language to improve proficiency in speaking. English day program implemented after school because it is including extracurricular activities that organized by an intra student organization. English day program based on habit in female student Wali Songo Islamic boarding school. This research aimed to know the implementation of English Day Program in English Speaking Improvement.

The method of this research was qualitative method. Students learn language from the basic until they apply it every day and the environment supports the activities as well. So, the implementation of English day program has been improved well for students' speaking.
